Chosen in view of her 'character, scholastic attainments and lengthened experience of domestic arrangements in large establishments'. Helped found the Association of Headmistresses.

Head 1889-1905

Cambridge MA. Installed fire escapes. Started Junior School in Berkeley House.



Oversaw evacuation to Cirencester and move to Worth Park. Died in office. Legacy helped in building gymnasium named for her.



Anne Askew Woodall

Dorothy M Henman
Head 1926–1939



Widowed in World War I. Head's house built for her and her young son. Favoured building of swimming pool.



Oversaw evacuation to Lynton in June 1940 with one week's notice, return to Worth Park in summer 1946 and final days of MMC.
